Remembering 9/11

On the anniversary of 9/11, memorials were held all over the United States, to remember those who died as heroes in the terrorist attacks on the World Trade Center, the pentagon, and those who died preventing the last hijacked plane from hitting it's target. The Cobb composite squadron went to the memorial service held at Kennesaw National Battlefield Park. There were over 3,000 flags erected, one for every person who died in the attacks on Sept. 11.

The Kiwanis Club of Marietta sponsored the event, and put the flags up. They had Roy Barnes as the keynote speaker. The Marine Aircraft Group 42, USMC sent representatives to perform the duties of the

firing detail. The 4th Force Service Support Group, U.S. Marine Corps, performed the flag detail/presentation. The ceremony was very moving and honored those that died on 9/11 as the heroes that they are.
