HOW TO PACK YOUR GEAR: Encampment requires a significant amount of equipment to be brought to the activity. The following packing guidelines should be used:	optional	Conservative Sunglasses with lanyard

<p>1. Choose a suitable suitcase or bag that you can easily access. Duffel bags should NOT be used because you must empty the contents of the bag entirely to get to the bottom during inspection. Use clear bags (if possible) for shower kits, etc.</p> <p>2. Bring uniforms on hangers pre-pressed and wrinkle free. Garment bags (if available) should be used; do not pack your uniforms in your main suitcase or bag.</p> <p>3. ONLY PACK WHAT IS ON THIS LIST. Do NOT bring something without permission from the Encampment Command Staff. EXCEPTION: Packing more quantities of clothing items than the minimal amounts listed above.</p> <p>4. 2x ABU uniforms, 1x each ABU and OCP uniform, or 2x OCP uniforms are acceptable to bring to encampment.</p> <p>Any items found that are not on the equipment list will be confiscated and placed in contraband until after graduation. DO NOT pack anything that is not authorized on this equipment list. Bringing of unauthorized items or failure to disclose is grounds for dismissal from encampment.</p> <p>If there are extenuating circumstances which necessitate you to bring items typically prohibited from the activity, contact the GAWG Encampment Staff at encampment.gawg.cap.gov prior to the Encampment to discuss.</p>
