<p>1. Choose a suitable suitcase or bag that you can easily access. Duffel bags should NOT be used because you must empty the contents of the bag entirely to get to the bottom during inspection. Use clear bags (if possible) for shower kits, etc.</p> <p>2. Bring uniforms on hangars pre-pressed and wrinkle free. Garment bags (if available) should be used; do not pack your uniforms in your main suitcase or bag.</p> <p>3. ONLY PACK WHAT IS ON THIS LIST. Do NOT bring something without permission from the Encampment Command Staff. EXCEPTION: Packing more quantities of clothing items than the minimal amounts listed above.</p> <p>Any items found that are not on the equipment list will be confiscated and placed in contraband until after graduation. Be accountable for your own actions and DO NOT pack anything that is not authorized on this equipment list. Bringing of unauthorized items or failure to disclose is grounds for dismissal from encampment.</p>
